Safe Fruits: Remove all pits, seed, rinds, and peels.

Safe Vegetables: Raw, cooked, or canned. Mostly importantly, plain.

Safe Meats: Cook well, unseasoned. Always remove bones.

- Grapes

Unsafe Vegetables:

- Garlic
- Leeks
- Potato, Tomato, & Eggplant
- Lily Plant
- Onions
- Avocado
- Leaves/Stems
- Tulip Plant
- Scallions
- Wild Mushrooms
- Rhubarb
- Hops
- Chives

Unsafe Protein Sources:

- Raw or Undercooked Meat/Fish
- Cooked Bones
- Macadamia Nuts
- Raw Eggs
- Walnuts

Unsafe Miscellaneous Foods:

- Alcohol
- Uncooked Bread Dough/Yeast
- Xylitol (synthetic sweetener commonly found in candy/gum)
- Caffeine
